Provide a leadership role in educating local govern-ment agencies throughout the State by standardizing regulatory safety requirements for proximate audience pyrotechnics. Review laws and regulations governing permits, licensure, inspection practices, pre-production, operations, post production, and open flames for various types of venues. Course incorporates a live proxi-mate audience pyrotechnics demonstration.
